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NEIGHBOURHOOD STORY

STRIPES has taken cues from the community's heritage, integrating the energy and culture of urban living into its foundation.

Take a stroll around the neighbourhood, immerse yourself in both past and present, as you explore family owned businesses that have been around for decades.



JALAN TUANKU ABDUL RAHMAN - one of the earliest main streets in Kuala Lumpur was once known as 'Batu Road'. The current name takes after the first elected King of Malaysia (then, Malaya), which coincidentally bares a similarity to our first Prime Minister's name, Tunku Abdul Rahman. (Tuanku, meaning His Majesty, while Tunku is Prince in Malay)



Along this street, one may find Pertama Complex, one of the earliest shopping malls in Kuala Lumpur, built in 1976. A popular mall for sporting goods, jeans wear and repairs, and now also for reasonably priced mobile phones.

On Saturdays, Jalan Tuanku Abdul Rahman is abuzz with locals and tourists alike thronging the streets to experience the weekly night market, selling from clothing to local delicacies and snacks.

At the other end of this street, a relic of the past still stands strong to this very day - The Coliseum Café & Hotel, which has been in business since 1921, still serves its popular Supreme Chicken Cordon Bleu, Grilled Chateaubriand and Hailam Noodles, a menu that was once favored by the European estate managers in the old' colonial days.
